



INSTRUCTIONS

Your 2021-2022 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for review in a process called verification. Federal regulations indicate that before awarding Federal Student Aid, we must ask you to confirm the information you reported on your FAFSA. To verify that you provided correct information we will compare your FAFSA with the information on this worksheet and with any other required documents. If there are differences, your FAFSA information may need to be corrected. You and at least one parent that signed the FAFSA (or your spouse in the case of independent students) must complete and sign this worksheet and submit the form with any other required documents to our office.

Verification of Household Size and Number in College

For Dependent Students list the people in your parent(s) household to include:

- **Yourself and your parent(s)** (including a stepparent) even if you don't live with your parent(s).
- **Your parent(s)' other children** if your parent(s) will provide more than half of their support from July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2022, or if the other children would be required to provide parental information if they were completing a FAFSA for 2021–2022. Include children who meet either of these standards, even if they do not live with your parent(s).
- **Other people** if they now live with your parent(s) and your parent(s) provide more than half of their support and will continue to provide more than half of their support through June 30, 2022.

For Independent Students list the people in your household to include:

- **Yourself.**
- **Your spouse**, if you are married.
- **Your children**, if any, if you will provide more than half of their support from July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2022, or if the child would be required to provide your information if they were completing a FAFSA for 2021–2022. Include children who meet either of these standards, even if they do not live with you.
- **Other people** if they now live with you and you provide more than half of their support and will continue to provide more than half of their support through June 30, 2022.

The 2021-2022 Verification of Family Member Enrollment form must be completed by the Financial Aid Office of the other school for each family member who is attending a school other than GW.
